
TUITION RESIDENCY STATUS GUIDELINES

It is the Administrative policy of the Southwestern Oregon Community College District that the following tuition status guidelines shall be used to determine the tuition classification for students.

United States Residency

A student who is not an International Student and who can document meeting one of the following residency/tuition status guidelines shall pay United States residency tuition.

The student shall:

1. be a foreign exchange student (J-1 visa) (i.e., American Field Service student, Rotary International student, etc.) residing with a host family in the United States; or
2. be an American Trust Territories resident, eligible for Federal financial aid.
3. be considered eligible for residency status as legislatively defined.

International Students

A student attending the college on a student visa (F-1, F-2), diplomatic visa (A-1, A-2), or a visitor visa (B-1, B-2, E-1) shall be classified as an International Student, and pay the assigned tuition for International Students.
