

CRIMINAL HISTORY BACKGROUND CHECK - As required by OCNE and the Oregon State Board of Nursing, all provisionally admitted students will be required to undergo a criminal background check prior to entering the program. Instructions will be included in the provisional admission packet. Individuals with a criminal record may not be allowed into a healthcare facility as a student. Because it is not possible to meet the objectives of the program without having clinical experience, anyone with a positive criminal or abuse history may not be eligible for acceptance in the nursing program.
