Reporting Unit Goals	<i>Instructional Administration:</i> It is evident from the data that we did meet our goal for LDC at 78.65%; for Occ Supp at 98.50%; for Postsecondary remedial at 61.47%, and for our average GPA for graduate and for program students. We did not meet our goals for Occ Prep at only 88.76%; however, we did demonstrate a significant improvement in this measure of achievement with an attainment of 98.5% of the target goal whereas last year's attainment was 95.9% of the target goal.
