

## 2021-22 Graduation and Transfer-out Rates Athletic HEOA Disclosure

The Higher Education Act of 1965, as amended by the Higher Education Opportunity Act of 2008, requires annual reporting and disclosure statements. Annually Southwestern must prepare the completion or graduation rate of its certificate or degree-seeking, full-time undergraduate students which must be published by July 1st, and the <a href="Spring IPEDS reporting">Spring IPEDS reporting</a> satisfies that deadline. Athletic graduation and transfer rates must also be published under the same timeframe and the following information satisfies the HEOA – Student Right to Know athletic graduation and transfer rates reporting requirements.

2021-2022 IPEDS Rates - Graduated by June 30, 2020: 2018-2019 Athletic Cohort 150% Reporting for 3 Year Completion and Transfer Rates

The fall 2018 Athletic cohort consists of 132 students who were enrolled as first-time full-time students and participated on an athletic team during the 2018-2019 academic year. Females represented 42% and 58% were males while 67% where white and 33% were minorities or indicated two or more races/chose not to report. Overall, 77% (101) of the students transferred or graduated within 150% of time (3 years) with a total of 36% graduating on time at 100% of time (2 years) and 44% graduated within 150% of time (3 years). Gender rates: 84% of females and 71% of males graduated or transferred within 3 years with 52% of females and 38% of males graduating within 150% of time (3 years). Students who indicated a minority status had a 80% combined graduation and transfer rate with a 41% graduation rate (3 years), while white students had a 75% combined graduation and transfer rate with a 45% graduation rate (3 years). The numbers by gender and for minority categories are not publically reported due to privacy restrictions when data is 7 or less. 2021-2022 IPEDS Rates - Graduated by June 30, 2020: 2017-2018 Athletic Cohort 200% Reporting for 4 Year Completion and Transfer Rates

The fall 2017 Athletic cohort consists of 149 students who were enrolled as first-time full-time students and participated on an athletic team during the 2017-2018 academic year. Females represented 42% and 58% were males while 69% where white and 31% were minorities or indicated two or more races/chose not to report. Overall, 73% (108) of the students transferred or graduated within 200% of time (4 years) and 71% at 150% of time (3 years). A total of 26% graduated on time at 100% of time (2 years), 36% graduated within 200% of time (4 years). Gender rates: 74% of females and 71% of males graduated or transferred within 4 years with 48% of females and 28% of males graduating within 200% of time (4 years). Students who indicated a minority status had a 63% combined graduation and transfer rate with a 24% graduation rate (4 years), while white students had a 77% combined graduation and transfer rate with a 42% graduation rate (4 years). The numbers by gender and for minority categories are not publically reported due to privacy restrictions when data is 7 or less. ## 2020-2021 IPEDS Rates - Graduated by June 30, 2020: 2017-2018 Athletic Cohort 150% Reporting for 3 Year Completion and Transfer Rates

The fall 2017 Athletic cohort consists of 149 students who were enrolled as first-time full-time students and participated on an athletic team during the 2017-2018 academic year. Females represented 42% and 58% were males while 69% where white and 31% were minorities or indicated two or more races/chose not to report. Overall, 71% (106) of the students transferred or graduated within 150% of time (3 years) with a total of 26% graduating on time at 100% of time (2 years) and 36% graduated within 150% of time (3 years). Gender rates: 73% of females and 70% of males graduated or transferred within 3 years with 48% of females and 26% of males graduating within 150% of time (3 years). Students who indicated a minority status had a 60% combined graduation and transfer rate with a 20% graduation rate (3 years), while white students had a 75% combined graduation and transfer rate with a 41% graduation rate (3 years). The numbers by gender and for minority categories are not publically reported due to privacy restrictions when data is 7 or less. ## 2020-2021 IPEDS Rates - Graduated by June 30, 2020: 2016-2017 Athletic Cohort 200% Reporting for 4 Year Completion and Transfer Rates

The fall 2016 Athletic cohort consists of 120 students who were enrolled as first-time full-time students and participated on an athletic team during the 2016-2017 academic year. Females represented 54% and 46% were males while 65% where white and 35% were minorities or indicated two or more races. Overall, 73% (87) of the students transferred or graduated within 200% of time (4 years). Gender Rates: 77% of females and 67% of males graduated within 200% of time (4 years) represented by students who indicated a minority status at 65% combined graduation and transfer rate and a graduation rate of 23% at 4 years. Athletes graduated within 150% of time (3 years) with a total of 28% graduating on time at 100% of time (2 years) and 31% graduated within 150% of time (3 years). Gender rates: 69% of females and 55% of males graduated or transferred within 3 years with 37% of females and 24% of males graduating within 150% of time (3 years). Students who indicated a minority status had a 60% combined graduation and transfer rate with a 23% graduation rate (3 years), while white students had a 63% combined graduation and transfer rate with a 37% graduation rate (3 years). The numbers by gender and for minority categories are not publically reported due to privacy restrictions when data is 7 or less.
