

## Southwestern Oregon Community College

### AP 3080 Traffic Control

It is the Administrative procedure of the Southwestern Oregon Community College District to adopt the following motor vehicle regulations for the campus of Southwestern Oregon Community College:

1. The speed limit shall be 20 miles per hour unless otherwise posted.
2. With the exception of Student Housing, the campus shall be closed to motor vehicles from 11 p.m. to 6:00 a.m., except by special permission.
3. Motor vehicle operators shall obey the one way traffic flow in circular parking lots. All motor vehicles shall park in designated areas as specified by the Vice President of Administrative Services.
4. All motor vehicles shall operate ONLY on roadways and in parking lots. No motor vehicles except for College approved vehicles are allowed on campus walkways except for the purposes of loading and unloading or for emergency purposes.
5. All other regulations for motor vehicles on the campus shall be in accordance with the laws of the State of Oregon and the ordinances of the City of Coos Bay.
6. Violations of this regulation by visitors may result in the person being asked to leave campus. Future violations or failure to leave the campus may result in an arrest for trespassing.

Traffic control signs will be posted on the campus of Southwestern Oregon Community College.
