ADMINISTRATIVE PROCEDURE

AP 4600 Administrative Withdrawal of Students

It is the policy of Southwestern Oregon Community College that an individual will be subject to involuntary administrative withdrawal from campus and related instruction if it is determined, by clear and convincing evidence, that the individual's behavior might result in actions which:

- a. pose a danger of causing physical harm to self or others, or
- b. could cause property damage, or
- c. could directly and substantially impede the educational process and/or the lawful activities of others.

The College reserves the right to request for good cause a physical, psychological, and/or psychiatric examination from a student at any time that the examination(s) may be in the best interest of the College and/or the student. Additionally, the College may require a behavioral agreement to be completed with the student.
