## AP 5700 Athletic Travel

It is the Administrative policy of Southwestern Oregon Community College that the following information outlines the policy for regional and national athletic travel.

## **REGIONAL AND CONFERENCE ATHLETIC TRAVEL**

All Southwestern Oregon Community College athletes participating in individual and team sports are eligible to compete in the regional/conference tournaments and should be entered.

Southwestern Oregon Community College will adhere to the standard operating procedures and eligibility requirements for each sport as outlined by the various athletic governing bodies such as, but not limited to: Northwest Athletic Conference and National Junior College Athletic Association.

The foregoing consideration shall be based upon the recommendation of the coach with director approval, contingent upon funding, and with final recommendation and approval made by the president.

Athletic Drug Testing The athletic department reserves the right to random drug testing at any time.
