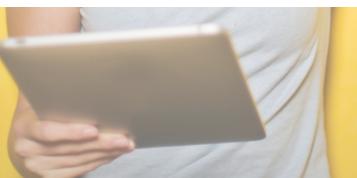
# Getting Started with Online Learning!





# Ready

#### **Technology Requirements**

- Access to a High-Speed Internet Connection
- Desktop/Laptop Mac or IBM Compatible
- PC Operating system should be Windows 7 or higher
- Mac Operating system should be 10.7 or higher
- Microsoft Office 365 (Available for free while attending SWOCC)
- Adobe Reader
- Internet Browser Google Chrome, Mozilla Firefox or Apple Safari (NOTE -Microsoft IE and Edge are not recommended for use with eLearning)
- Other software may be required on a course by course basis

#### **Required Skill Set**

- Ability to create, name, save and find your documents
- Download and upload documents as well as attach to and save from email
- Transfer files via USB drive and/or cloud storage
- Ability to search for and determine legitimate Internet source material
- Self-motivation, persistence, time management: Know that online learning has a unique set of challenges and objectives not found in face to face classrooms
